WHO WE ARE

See U Next 2sday is a local arts activism group based in Northeast Ohio. We work closely with Indivisible NEO (INEO) and serve as its Arts Committee, using creativity, skill, and collective action to defend democracy and care for our communities.

We believe creativity belongs to everyone — and that art can be a powerful tool for awareness, solidarity, and action. You don't have to be an artist to participate. You just have to care.

WHY WE CREATED THESE WHISTLES

Across the country, communities are using whistles to alert others when ICE, Border Patrol, or related enforcement activity is present nearby. These whistles are a simple, non-violent way to look out for one another and help people stay informed and safe. Please see the next page to learn more about what an ICE whistle is and the history of how they came about.

Our goal with the Next 2sday Whistles is to bring creativity into this effort.

By designing whistles that are attractive, personal, and wearable, we hope to:

- » Make participation more approachable and visible
- » Spark curiosity and conversation among people who may not yet be engaged
- » Help at-risk individuals feel safer carrying a whistle that is not immediately identifiable as an ICE alert tool
- » Show that protecting one another — and our democracy — can be both practical and expressive

In short: we're using art to make community care more visible, more accessible, and yes — more fashionable.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THIS PACKET

This packet is designed to work alongside an online video tutorial, while also supporting those who prefer written instructions or already have experience working with polymer clay.

In addition to the supply list, this packet contains:

- » A consolidated step-by-step guide for making a whistle (for experienced polymer clay users who may not need the video tutorial)
- » Instructions for assembling whistle packets and supplies
- » A printable zine, including:
 - Instructions for folding the zine

WHAT IS AN ICE WHISTLE?

An ICE whistle is a community alert tool. When used responsibly, it can help notify people nearby that immigration enforcement activity may be occurring in the area, allowing individuals to be more aware of their surroundings and make informed decisions.

Whistles are **not** about confrontation. They are about communication, mutual aid, and looking out for one another.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF ICE WHISTLES

ICE whistles emerged as a grassroots community safety tool in Los Angeles and were later popularized in Chicago in late 2024 and 2025. These whistles became part of a decentralized, rapid-response system designed to alert communities when immigration enforcement activity was occurring nearby. The goal was simple and powerful: to make enforcement activity loud, visible, and public, countering quiet raids or sudden detentions and helping neighbors look out for one another in real time.

A FINAL NOTE

This project is rooted in care, creativity, and community responsibility. Whether you're making one whistle or many, wearing one yourself or leaving one for someone else to find, you are part of a larger collective effort to look out for one another.

SUPPLIES FOR MAKING NEXT 2SDAY WHISTLES

A QUICK NOTE ABOUT SUPPLIES

Some of the reference links in this packet point to Amazon simply because they are easy to find and clearly show the type of item we use. We do not receive any compensation or kickbacks from these links. We also know many people are intentionally avoiding Amazon right now, and we fully support that choice. Please feel free to use the links only as a visual reference, then source similar items wherever you prefer.

Local art and craft stores often carry the same or comparable supplies, and many items on this list can be substituted with things you may already have at home. Experiment, improvise, and make it your own. If you discover alternatives that work especially well (or are just more fun), we'd love to learn from you. MUST HAVES

Polymer Clay

Our research showed Sculpey Premo to be the most reliable option for this project, with Fimo Professional as a strong alternative. We use Sculpey Premo, but if you already have polymer clay on hand, feel free to experiment.

If you try a different brand and it works well, please let us know. Sculpey Premo is often available at Michael's (please do not support Hobby Lobby), independent art stores, larger chain craft stores, and online retailers.

Whistles

We use small aluminum emergency whistles as the base for this project. These are safe for baking.

HELPFUL (BUT YOU CAN IMPROVISE)

These tools make the process easier, but many can be replaced with items you already have.

- » Acrylic tray or self-healing mat
- » Acrylic roller
- » Clay cutter
- » Needle tool
- » X-Acto or precision knife
- » Clay tools (especially ball-tipped metal or plastic shaping tools)
- » Cording for a necklace (thin leather cord, rope, or soft ribbon)
- » Paper towels (for oil application or cleanup)
- » Cooking oil (used lightly — see video)
- » Parchment paper
- » Baking sheet
- » Paper for printing inserts
- » Zip-lock bags (for whistle packets)
- » Tape (packing tape preferred)
- » Polymer clay molds (advanced users)
- » Pasta roller or pasta-making machine (clay use only)

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

FOR EXPERIENCED POLYMER CLAY CREATORS

If you are new to polymer clay or would prefer to see this process demonstrated, we strongly recommend watching our tutorial video. A link can be found at the bottom of this page.

1. Roll clay into a thin square, approximately 2.25" × 2.25".
2. Wrap clay around the aluminum whistle and secure it to the metal body.
3. Add clay to the top of the whistle to create enough thickness to punch a hole for necklace cording.
4. Fully clear the open end of the whistle.
5. Fully clear the top cutout, paying close attention to the small side chamber closest to the open end.
6. Test the whistle.
7. If it works, continue.
8. If it doesn't, clay is likely blocking the small chamber between the open end and the top cutout.
9. Decorate and add finishing details.
10. Preheat oven to 275°F.
11. Place whistle on a parchment-lined baking sheet.
12. Bake for approximately 15–20 minutes, depending on thickness.
13. Allow whistle to cool completely.
14. String necklace cord through the whistle.
15. Place whistle in a bag (use a weather-resistant zip-top bag if placing outdoors).
16. Print the zine (double-sided) and fold according to instructions later in this packet.
17. Place the folded zine and 'sharing' insert in the bag.
18. For whistles placed outdoors, also include the English and Spanish cover pages found later in this packet.
19. Affix them to the inside of the bag with tape (packing tape works best), with "Finders Keepers!" and "¡El que lo encuentra, se lo queda!" facing outward.
20. Position printed materials toward the bottom of the bag to allow for cinching.
21. Gently press excess air out of the bag and seal.
22. Cinch the top of the bag with ribbon, string, or cord.
23. Optional: tie into a bow for presentation.
24. If placing outdoors, add an additional length of ribbon or cord so the bag can be hung (e.g., from a tree branch).
25. Hang out of reach — these are intended for adults to find and use.
26. Distribute.

WHISTLE PACK ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place the finished whistle in a bag.
 - Use a weather-resistant Zip-lock type bag if the whistle will be placed outdoors.
2. Print the Zine double-sided.
 - You will find the printable version of the Zine later in this packet.
 - Follow the instructions on folding the Zine which are included later in this packet.
3. Print the How To Post insert double-sided.
 - You will find the printable version of the How To Post insert later in this packet.
4. Place the folded zine and How To Post insert in the bag with the whistle.
5. Print the Cover Sheets double sided and affix it to the bag.
 - You will find the printable version of the Cover Sheets later in this packet (one in English & one in Spanish)
6. Affix the Cover Sheets to the inside of the bag with tape (packing tape works best).
 - Tape “Finders Keepers!” and “¡El que lo encuentra, se lo queda!” so they face outward - English on one side of the bag & Spanish on the other side of the bag.
 - Position these cover sheets toward the bottom of the bag to allow for cinching.
7. Gently press excess air out of the bag and seal it.
8. Cinch the top of the bag with ribbon, string, or cord.
 - *Optional:* tie into a bow for presentation.
9. If placing the whistle outdoors, add an additional length of ribbon, string, or cord so the bag can be hung (for example, from a tree branch).
 - Ideally, hang out of reach of children — these are intended for adults to find and use.
10. Distribute.


